**Memorandum of Understanding**

**KAHRANI GREEN TREATERS ASSOCIATION (KGTA)**

**AND**

This Memorandum of understanding made at Bhiwadi on the .....day of ..... between **Kahrani Green Treaters Association (KGTA)** registered under the Companies Act, 2013 having its Registered office at Plot No.01, RIICO Commercial Complex, Industrial Area, Chopanki, Bhiwadi, Alwar Rajasthan of the one part AND M/s..... having Registered office ....., Bhiwadi (Raj.) of the second part.

RIICO intends to establish a Common Effluent Treatment Plant (CETP) at Kahrani for treatment of effluents from Industries and the work of the said CETP to be built at RIICO Industrial Area, Shahdod is handed over to **Kahrani Green Treaters Association** for construction and operation & maintenance.

KGTA intends to establish CETP for treatment of Industrial Effluents of the Industrial Area putting their best efforts, experience and technologies to ensure treatment of effluents up to parameters/standards decided by CPCB/RSPCB.

The main objectives of KGTA are as under: -

- 1. To meet the prescribed standards of Inlet & Outlet effluent.
- 2. To minimize the effluent discharge.

In order to facilitate the successful running of CETP Project, KGTA is entering in to this MOU with .....

This MOU shall come into effect from.....

**KGTA (CETP) Project and Scope of MOU**

- 1. KGTA has the mandate from Industries and Industrial Associations to run and oversee the CETP, Kahrani with past experience, expertise, skill, technologies by following democratic norms and standard uniform procedures for all.

## 2. KGTA Shall: -

- 1) KGTA becomes a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) for management of CETP.
- 2) KGTA will ensure that the incoming Industrial effluents are treated in a manner and meets with the CPCB/RSPCB prescribed standards.
- 3) KGTA will continue to strive for technology, man power, skill improvement in effluent treatment process to meet the changing environment needs and requirements.
- 4) KGTA will provide adequately trained staff for effective and efficient as well as cost effective running of the CETP at all time.
- 5) KGTA will evolve a suitable mechanism for smooth functioning of the CETP.
- 6) KGTA will plan for capacity enhancement as and when required.
- 7) KGTA will have a full-fledged laboratory facility for the monitoring of the CETP performance as well as continuous up-gradation and optimization of the plant along with R&D of the treatment procedures.
- 8) KGTA will categorize the industries located in industrial area in consultation with RIICO & RSPCB as per prevailing norms.
- 9) KGTA will levy Membership Charges, CETP Charges (Project construction cost and O&M cost) in consultation with RIICO & RSPCB and make yearly revision thereof to meet the expense incurred/ to be incurred on operation & Maintenance of CETP.
- 10) KGTA will collect the CETP charges from the member units for Project construction and O&M of CETP.
- 11) KGTA will timely intimate to the member units about their Project construction and O&M charges for depositing the same within the due date.
- 12) KGTA will issue membership receipt on payment of prescribed fees to the industries on submission of relevant information on non-judicial stamp paper regarding Raw-material, Product, Production capacity, Plot area, source of water, raw water consumption & waste water generation, treatment and discharge quantity.
- 13) KGTA will ensure procurement of all chemicals, spare parts, machineries, fuels etc. required for waste water treatment well in advance for ensuring adequate availability of quality and quantity of the items.
- 14) KGTA will carry out surprise checks of the industries in order to check quality and quantity of effluent being discharged by units.
- 15) KGTA will revoke memberships and take appropriate action as and when required against defaulting units in consultation with RSPCB & RIICO or Govt. of Rajasthan in general.
- 16) KGTA will ensure that annual account be audited by a firm of Chartered Accountant every year and Audited Annual Account approved by Annual General Meeting of KGTA.
- 17) KGTA will ensure to organize the meeting of the Board of Directors once in a month and Annual general body meeting once in a year and any other meetings with a proper intimation to the member units.

- 18) KGTA ensure that hazardous waste will be sent to Authorized TSDF sites or to cement industries through a authorized transporter for its ultimate disposal & co-processing after obtaining the necessary permissions for the same.
- 19) KGTA will develop a green belt area, for development & maintenance of green belt.
- 20) KGTA will follow practice of medical check -up facility for the employees & their families in accordance to the requirement of Factories Act for which the services of qualified medical officer, PHC or a Private Hospital will be rendered.
- 21) KGTA will implement Occupational health & Safety plan.
- 22) KGTA will ensure compliances of all the government norms and procure permissions from the government departments.

**3. M/s ..... shall: -**

- 1) Abide by specific condition in the Membership Terms & Conditions.
- 2) Will be equipped with their own waste treatment plants, so that the inlet effluent quality to CETP will meet the prescribed standards.
- 3) Will daily monitor the specified parameters of the effluent & its flow and the data will be submitted to KGTA on regular basis.
- 4) The Unit shall use single well-defined outlet for discharge of waste into the conveyance system attached to CETP, such outlet shall be well equipped with Electro-magnetic flow meter & online pH metering and recording system.
- 5) The unit shall recycle effluents within its premises up to maximum possible extent either in the process or for gardening/plantation subject to the conformity with the standard prescribed by RSPCB.
- 6) The unit shall have to comply with the conditions imposed by RSPCB, CPCB, MoEF & other government departments time to time.
- 7) Will regularly pay their share towards meeting CETP project construction & O&M expenses.
- 8) Any change in the information provided at the time of membership by the unit should be intimated to the KGTA & also be approved from RIICO & RSPCB.
- 9) No dues Certificate to be obtained from KGTA.
